About the state of Mato Grosso

Mato Grosso is the biggest soybean, corn, cotton, beef cattle and sunflower producing area in Brazil. There are 3 biomass - Cerrado, Amazon and Pantanal. The state capital is Cuiabá, 450km south of Sorriso.

Sorriso

Worldwide, Sorriso is known as the national soybean capital. The municipality is only 33 years old; most of its production goes out through the North ports in Pará state.

The municipality of Sorriso is one of the biggest fish producers in Brazil, one of the top five fish producing countries in the world.

Cases of responsible production, such as the certified farms we propose to visit above, can be empowered and multiplied - The PCI Strategy in Sorriso endorsed by RTRS.

In Sorriso, **the PCI Strategy** is rolling out the **PCI Program** based on its three pillars: Produce, Conserve and Include.

Last June 2019, RTRS joined the Sorriso PCI program signing a Memorandum of Understanding together with CAT Sorriso and IDH, aimed at driving sustainable soy and low-carbon agricultural and livestock production in Sorriso with a new jurisdictional approach.

This cooperation initiative is intended, among other things, to support farmers and traders in the region engaged in responsible soy production and to help develop a jurisdictional market approach towards 100% responsible production, which includes driving the expansion of RTRS certified soybean production areas to reach 150,000 hectares by 2024.
