#### I. HOW TO USE THIS DOCUMENT

This document has been created for the application for formal recognition of certification bodies under RTRS standards.

In <u>section A</u> you will find the <u>general requirements</u> for all applications (either application for recognition regarding the scope of the agricultural standard or chain of custody).

In <u>section B</u> you will find the recognition requirements under the <u>RTRS standard for soy production (P&C)</u>

In <u>section C</u> you will find the recognition requirements under the <u>Chain of Custody</u> (CoC) <u>Standard</u>

For example:

If you apply for preliminary or total recognition under the RTRS standard for soy production, you shall complete sections A and B, and relevant annexes.

If you apply for preliminary or total recognition under the Chain of Custody standard, you shall complete sections A and C, and relevant annexes.

If you apply for preliminary or total recognition under both standards, you shall complete sections A, B and C, and relevant annexes.

### II. RECOGNITION FEES

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When applying for the first time, payment shall be made in two steps:

First payment: 50% after preliminary recognition is granted (USD 1800). Second payment: remaining 50% after total recognition is granted (remaining USD 1800).

When applying for recognition of a second RTRS standard (i.e., when RTRS preliminary or total recognition has been previously granted under the agricultural standard or chain of custody), the USD 1500 amount shall be totally charged when granting preliminary recognition of the second requested standard.

These fees are charged only once, except that the certification body fails to comply with the deadlines established in the RTRS standards accreditation and verification systems, then you must, if authorized by RTRS, apply and pay again for the costs associated with recognition.

\*When the Certification Bodies fail to fulfill the requirements when submitting the application for recognition (e.g, incomplete documentation, lack of proof of the records required, documentation that does not apply for the scope of recognition), and this leads to perform a new review of the application, the RTRS will charge an extra review fee of USD 800.
